

CLUBS FOR KIDS 2023 Scholarship Application

The Clubs For Kids Foundation offers a scholarship opportunity for eligible students at the following schools: Atchison High School, Atchison County Community Junior/Senior High, Maur Hill-Mount Academy, and Home School Students of Atchison County. The scholarship provides financial assistance to scholarship winners for their continued education. For 2023 Clubs For Kids will offer a total of nine scholarships. Three \$3000.00 Joseph K. Julo Memorial Scholarships will be awarded to the top three graduating senior applicants, and six \$1500.00 scholarships to all qualified 10th through 12th grade high school applicants. All applicants must meet the requirements and criteria listed below.

Joseph K. Julo established the Clubs For Kids Foundation in 2007 to provide an avenue for children to learn the fundamental game of golf who might not otherwise have the opportunity. In 2008 the Foundation began an educational scholarship program that has awarded 141 scholarships to students in Atchison County schools.

The Foundation funds this scholarship program through the annual "Clubs For Kids Golf Tournament" along with cash donations.

All applicants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Enrolled as a student in a high school in Atchison County, Kansas.
- 2. Attending grades 10 through 12 during the 2022-2023 school year.

Criteria for judging applications:

- 1. Quality of Essay
- 2. Participation in extracurricular activities or community service.
- 3. Recommendation from community member. Use form provided.
- 4. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 verified with official cumulative school transcript.

To apply, complete the attached scholarship application. Please type or print clearly. All applications must be submitted to Clubs for Kids Foundation at P.O. Box 274, Atchison Kansas 66002 and postmarked no later than **April 21, 2023.**

Verification of enrollment from a vocational-technical school, 2- or 4-year college of your choice will be needed to release any scholarship funds awarded. If a scholarship winner chooses not to continue his or her education after high school, the scholarship award will not be awarded to that individual. Recipients have 30 months from the awarding of the scholarship to access the money. Unclaimed funds will be made available to future scholarship applicants 2023
